The above puppy is believed to be in good health, should you wish to take it to your own veterinary surgeon for a general health check this should be done within three days of purchase. This check and any other tests or examinations associated with it must be at your own expense. If your vet finds any problem, which, in his opinion, renders the puppy unfit for sale, I will take back the puppy and refund the purchase price in full, on condition that the puppy is returned immediately and is in the same state of health as it was sold. If, I, the breeder, am unhappy about the condition of the puppy on its return I will have it examined by my own vet, at my own expense, before any monies are returned.

I/We the undersigned have been informed by the breeder regarding any genetic or partly genetic disease that this breed may be affected by, i.e. hip dysplasia, and the recently diagnosed late onset PRA for which a DNA test is now available via the Animal Health Trust, and the liver/tan/red colour gene for which a DNA test is available via Optigen USA, the latter in no way affects the health of the animal. The health tests do not need to be undertaken unless the animal is to be bred from. I/We are aware that there is no guarantee that the puppy will be free from disease, genetic or otherwise, to which it may be prone. I/We accept that if such a disease develops later in life, after a satisfactory examination by a veterinary surgeon as stated above, the breeder will not be held responsible. However, where required, and if feasible, the parents of your puppy have undergone the above health tests and their certificates are in your puppy pack.

I/We declare that it is the intention to keep and care for the puppy for the whole of its life. If circumstances change to the extent that it unfortunately ever becomes necessary for the dog to be rehomed, I/We will offer the breeder first refusal to take care of any rehoming that may be required. I do not refund the purchase price.

The breeder has supplied me/us with a puppy pack containing a signed pedigree with all the hip scores relating to the pedigree (if known) and a copy of the parents BVA/HD score forms. Also Kennel Club registration documents and relevant information on owning and rearing a Gordon Setter, plus feeding and worming information. Also a small supply of food on which the puppy is currently being fed. Your puppy will leave my premises with a puppy insurance cover, microchipped and first vaccination. On the expiry of the puppy insurance it is your responsibility to renew this, either with the same company or one of your choice.

The breeder has also informed me/us that the puppy's Kennel Club registration is endorsed – progeny not eligible for registration and not eligible for the issue of an Export Pedigree – and has explained to me the meaning of this. This does not affect your ownership. Should the puppy be shown at championship level and attain a high level of success and be suitable to be bred from in the consideration of the breeder and providing that the relevant BVA/KC health schemes applicable at that time are passed satisfactorily, I **may** have the endorsements removed, providing that I the breeder am in agreement with any proposed matings which will be placed in writing prior to any breeding commencement.
